

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BIRCH HILLS NO. 460

BYLAW NO. 01-2015

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF WATER AND TO FIX THE WATER RATES TO BE CHARGED AND THE SEWER SERVICE CHARGE IN THE HAMLET OF BRANCEPETH.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills No. 460 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. ALL persons desiring to be supplied with water from the Hamlet's water supply system shall make application to the officials of the municipality. Each application shall be accompanied by the payment of a fee of \$4,285.71.
2. The municipality shall have the right to ration or limit the amount of water furnished to any and or all consumers should circumstances seem to warrant such action.
3. A charge of \$50.00 dollars shall be made for shutting off the water service and a charge of \$50.00 dollars shall be made for subsequently turning on the water service.
4. If the water supply is shut off from the premises of a user for infringement of the provisions of this bylaw, same shall not be turned on until all penalties, fees and arrears, if any, have been paid.
5. The following rates shall apply for use of water:

A minimum of \$180.00 for 9,300 gallons every three months plus \$16.00/1,000 gallons over the minimum will be charged. Persons obtaining water from the coin operated pump outlet shall pay \$.020 per gallon of water.
6. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are by bylaw required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such service a service charge of \$22.50 per quarter (\$90.00 per year).
7. All rates or charges imposed under this bylaw are payable quarterly at the office of the Administrator and shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee.

That Bylaw No. 02-2010 is hereby repealed.
