

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BIRCH HILLS NO. 460

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 1 - 95 RESPECTING A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY.

The council of the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills No. 460 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Bylaw No. 1 - 95 adopted on April 12th, 1995 is hereby amended by striking out


1. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property described as:  
2 acres described as: Commencing at the South West corner of the Quarter Section; thence Northerly along the Western boundary of the Quarter Section 295 feet and 2 inches; thence Easterly parallel with the Southern boundary of the Quarter Section 295 feet and 2 inches; thence Southerly parallel with the Western boundary to the Southern boundary; thence Westerly along the Southern boundary to the point of commencement,

and substituting therefore the following:

1. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property described as:

All that portion of the South West Quarter of Section 22, Township 46, Range 23, West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan 2 acres described as: Commencing at the South West corner of the Quarter Section; thence Northerly along the Western boundary of the Quarter Section 295 feet and 2 inches; thence Easterly parallel with the Southern boundary of the Quarter Section 295 feet and 2 inches; thence Southerly parallel with the Western boundary to the Southern boundary; thence Westerly along the Southern boundary to the point of commencement.
