BYLAW NO.02/01

A BYLAW WITH RESPECT TO LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY

The council of the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills, No. 460 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


DEFINITIONS:


- (a) "Livestock" as used in this bylaw means cattle, goats, horses, sheep, swine and all fur bearing animals.
  - (b) "Poultry" means chickens, ducks, geese and turkeys
1. No person shall herd livestock at any time within the limits of the Hamlet of Hagen.
  2. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry at any time within the limits of the Hamlet of Hagen.
  4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of this municipality. That being, a penalty not exceeding five hundred dollars and costs for every offence and in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days unless the said penalty and costs including costs of committal, are sooner paid. (Bylaw #120)


This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of its passing.
