

BYLAW NO. 122

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE HAMLETS OF BRANCEPETH, HAGEN, OR FENTON.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills, No. 460 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:

(a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Highways Act, but shall not include provincial highway as designated in pursuance of such Act:

(b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Act.


2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 40 kilometres per hour on any public highway within any of the hamlets of Brancepeth, Hagen, or Fenton.

3. Section 2 shall not apply to the operators of fire engines, and fire department apparatus and operators of an ambulance where these vehicles are being operated on emergency duty and employing the siren and flashing red lights.

4. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.


5. Bylaw No. 119 is hereby repealed.
